## Awards

We have yet to finalize the awards and categories.

Boat entries must complete the parade route and obey parade rules to be eligible for prizes and awards. **Each boat can only win one prize.**

## Rules and Procedures

1. Vessel must be pre-registered and carry a Flotilla Vessel ID Number on the **starboard** side forward.
2. Vessel must be registered by noon on Thursday, December 1, 2016.
3. Vessel must have a current state registration.
4. A **mandatory** Captains' meeting will be held at the Roanoke Island Maritime Museum on Thursday, December 3rd at 6:00 p.m. Additional rules and procedures may be addressed at this time.
5. Staging area for parade participants is the area just East of the Roanoke Marshes Lighthouse. (between the lighthouse and net shed).
6. Parade lineup will begin at 5:15 p.m. Participants should be prepared to begin at 5:30 p.m.
7. Parade instructions will be issued on VHF Channel 72. Monitor 72 at all times.
8. Travel at a continuous "no wake" speed. Stay within 200 feet of the boat in front of you.
9. Parade route will proceed from the lighthouse, into Doughs Creek along the town docks, turn at the bridge, back past the gazebo (reviewing stand), out past the lighthouse and one more trip into Doughs Creek. Judging will be done on the second (2nd) pass of the gazebo. Please put your number on the starboard side of your vessel, up forward where it is visible.
10. The judges' reviewing stand will be located on the gazebo. Captains should bring their vessels within 100 feet of the reviewing stand but **do not stop/turn/spin**.
11. By law, no fireworks of any kind allowed.

Please use common sense, be respectful of other parade participants, and be respectful of other boaters. Be Safe, Have Fun and Enjoy the Parade!
